3. The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.
4. Joint early voting shall be conducted by personal appearance and by mail. The period for early voting by personal appearance for the general election shall be October 23 through November 3, 2023. Optical scan ballots shall be used for early voting by mail and direct recording electronic voting machines shall be used for early voting by personal appearance. The Early Voting Clerk for said elections shall be the Brazos County Election Administrator. She shall determine the number of election workers to be hired and arrange for training of all election workers. Early voting by personal appearance for the general election shall be conducted jointly at the locations and on the following dates and times specified by the Brazos County Election Administrator:



Last Day to receive an application for ballot by mail is Friday, October 27, 2023 at 5:00 pm. The Election Administrator's Office can mail applications for the voter to fill out and return or the voter can write a letter stating their name, local address, address where they are, reason why their voting absentee and it must include the voter's signature.
